



Progress notes December 2009

Proposed route for cyclists and walkers linking Potter Heigham, Ludham, Horning and Hoveton/Wroxham with a riverside loop along the River Thurne

- A Full Application for Funding submitted to NNCP at the end of August 2009 was successful. Match funding to reach a total sum of £20,000 will be necessary in order to secure the NNCP contribution of £4952. The Association is awaiting news of funding bids to partners to secure the balance. Funding will enable the Association to buy in the fundraising expertise required to secure funding for sections of the route.
- The Association has received £63.75 from a successful Community Chest application
- In November Norman Lamb MP gave support to the project by cycling from Hoveton to Potter Heigham accompanied by County Cllr Paul Rice and District Cllr Barbara McGoun and there was good coverage in the local press.

- The Association's AGM will take place on Tuesday 20th April 2010. Venue: Annex of Horning Village Hall.
